

Uniform Policy

To ALL Coaches and their staff

On behalf of the Competition Committee, I wish to remind you of some of the policies that you are governed by. I get many phone calls regarding the uniform policy. Here it is and what it means.

6:02:17 HOME TEAM UNIFORM COLORS

As a general rule, the home team should wear their darker colored jersey and the visitors their lighter one. If there is still a conflict, the home team must change.

Below is an example of what this translates into or means:

The home team should be in their dark colors (socks and jersey). The away team must be in their lighter colors (socks and jersey). Therefore, If a team has red and black as their colors, their home jersey will be their black kit and their red kits will be their away. If the aforementioned team visits another team whose colors are red and white. Making it so the home team is red and the away team is red. The home team shall change to their white colors.

If a team is blue and white and is traveling away they shall expect to wear their white kits and not their blue kits. A traveling team shall not, out of disrespect to the opponent, officials, and to the game, wear their dark uniforms and expect the home team to change because the traveling teams doesn't want to wear their lighter colored kits or for another other reason.

Please respect the game by adhering to this simple policy.
