REGISTRATION FEE. A player registration fee will be established each year to pay for necessary program expenses such as uniform (optional for competition teams which are not required to use the official league uniform), team equipment which may include but is not limited to the following: (a bag, three balls, six cones, a goalie shirt and a first aid kit), field equipment and maintenance, league administrative support, accident reimbursement plan, liability insurance, State Office administration and national USYS dues. UYSA leagues are authorized to set their own registration fees, subject to approval by their District Committee. The Board of Directors at their discretion can offer incoming leagues lower fees for a limited time. Only the league president or the authorized agent that collects the registration fees can authorize a refund of any or all of the registration fees. Neither the district nor the state has the authority to change the league president's decision.

Membership fee requirements for "recognized member of USSF" who are participating in UYSA sanctioned activities and registered with another organization must fulfill the requirements of USSF Bylaw 212 and 213. Dual fees for the same requirement such as Federation and Insurance fees are not required so long as one organization or the other is fulfilling the requirements. USYSA and UYSA specific fee requirements and/or exceptions for those organization participating with another Federation organization and USYSA/UYSA will be developed by the UYSA BOD and published as a policy.

IX. RATIONALE

Allows for members of USSF affiliates also affiliating with UYSA to deduct duplicate USSF fees and Insurance fees.
