1:06 TERRITORIES AND BOUNDARIES

1:06:01 The territory of this Association shall be the State of Utah.

1:06:02 The Board of Directors shall create geographical subdivisions within the territory which shall be known as "Districts". A District shall consist of two (2) or more Leagues or Affiliated Clubs.

II. HOW THE RULE WOULD BE CHANGED

1:06 TERRITORIES AND BOUNDARIES

1:06:01 The territory of this Association shall be the State of Utah.

1:06:02 The Board of Directors shall create geographical subdivisions within the territory which shall be known as "Districts". A District shall consist of two (2) or more Leagues or Affiliated Clubs.

The BOD may, from time to time, create Districts at Large (DaL) for the purpose of fostering activities such as specific types or levels of competition within UYSA. DaL's will function in the same manner and be accorded the same constitutional rights as other Districts but will operate without defined geographic boundaries. DaL will function autonomously in accordance with their approved Constitution, Bylaws, and Rules. Newly affiliated DaL's are subject to the approval of the State Council at the following Annual General Meeting. Voting rights are designated in accordance with 2:01:01 and 2:02:02. UYSA shall encourage all districts not to discriminate against DaL's in the assignment of fields for the scheduling of matches and games.

Allows for USSF affiliates to also affiliate with UYSA.
