

Independent Teams

How to register your team as an independent team with Utah Youth Soccer

Each team must have the following in order to compete in UYSA Gaming League

1. Team Administrators

- Head Coach (Coaching License Required)
- Assistant Coach (Coaching License Required)
- Team Manager
 - Coaching License Requirements
 - Head coach or assistant coach of a team must have a USSF "E" License, Grassroots License, Season Waiver, or "D" License.
- 2. Secure a home field o Fields can be contracted with cities, school districts, or private entities.
 - After you have secured your home field, you will need to request a Certificate of Liability by filling out an online form <u>here</u>.
- **3.** Contract with a Certified League Registrar o A list of certified league registrars can be found on our website under the About tab Who We Are- Certified Registrars page.
 - The registrar list is broken up based on regions, but you can contract with ANY certified registrar.
 - Your registrar will make sure you meet all deadlines and team requirements in order to compete in the league
 - Fall Deadline to have your team registered and applied to the league July 1
 - Spring Deadline to have your team registered and applied to the league February 1
- **4. Contract with a Certified Ref Assignor** o A list of ref assignors can be found on our website under the Resources Referee Info

Certified Registrars and Ref Assignors are independent contractors and will charge fees for their services

5. Fill out and turn in the Independent Team Application to Carly Brown (cbrown@utahyouthsoccer.net) . Form can be found on our website under the Resources tab - Download Center.

Coaching License Details

- <u>Grassroots License</u> allows an applicant to be rostered as a coach or assistant coach on one or more competitive teams in any age group or play level (bracket) except in the U14-U19 Premier 1 or/and 2 levels.
- <u>D License (or higher)</u> allows an applicant to be rostered as a head coach on one or more U14-U19 Premier 1 or/and 2 levels. (also covers all teams under the Grassroots License)
- <u>E License</u> allows an applicant to be rostered as a coach or assistant coach on one or more competitive teams in any age group or play level (bracket) except in the U14-U19 Premier 1 or/and 2 levels.
