IREF Recap – Bryan Attridge

Bryan recapped the IREF program which is a recreation referee instructor program. UYSA is providing this training at no cost to the UYSA recreation programs. Eight clubs participated in this program this Fall season. There were 232 referees trained in this program so far.

Referee Fee Proposal – Scott Jones

Scott introduces 11 initiatives that the SRC has created in an effort to increase the referee pool and keep referees coming back each year. Due to COVID almost 1,000 referees did not return. Through a year of recruiting and scholarship opportunities for certification the SRC has increased the number of certified referees back to about 2,000. Scott reviewed with the board the pay rates for non-UYSA programs and how it has impacted the recruitment of solid referees into our programing.

Brian Smith is very encouraging of the increasing the pay rate for the UYSA referees. Toby Yoshida brainstorms the idea of tiering pay based on a number of games refed or somehow incentivize referees to ref more games.

Brian Babcock questions where the funds will come from to pay the referee crew if a national level (for example) shows up instead of a grassroots level referee. UYSA office will research potential costs and will have a proposal for the February board meeting.

Referee Recruitment – add a team/add a referee – Brian Smith

Brian explores the idea of developing the program of "add a team, add a ref." The board investigates different ideas how part of the requirements of receiving funds from the Special Programs grants would be contingent upon providing certified referees.

Adult Soccer Formation Committee – John Gygi

John Gygi proposes creating a working committee for the development of the adult program in conjunction with the current adult association.

Bryan reiterates that the development of the adult program will be self-sufficient and

staffed. It will not take away any resources or focus from the youth programs.

6325 Alignment – Scot Boyd

Scot Boyd discusses alignment policy and if club continuity should be changed slightly. Hybrid options will be reviewed and discussed by both the competition sub-committee and in the technical leadership meetings. Discussion or business item will be brought back up in the February board meeting if office staff support a change based on feedback.
