6317 - Unscored or Unplayed Games - Cindy Baron & Scot Boyd

Cindy explains the intent of this policy change is to try to encourage teams to play their games and not leave any games as abandoned or un-played at the end of the season. This change will allow the league commissioner or designated staff member to record games that are "abandoned not played" with negative points, no points, or award a "win" if necessary.

Zig Peacock motions to approve Lisa Brockbank seconds motion

Toby requests staff keep a log of all games that do not get played due to exceptional circumstances such as teams refusing to travel and the reasons why to see if this policy change has an effect in the future.

Brian Babcock suggests adding language "3 points for 1 team, no points for either team"

6315(6)(e) - US Youth Logo

US Youth Soccer no longer requires that all uniforms must include US Youth Soccer logo. UYSA will follow suit and not require their logo on uniforms.

6315(12)(f) - Yellow Card Accumulation - Coaches

In accordance with the FIFA change allowing the issuance of red and yellow cards to coaches, UYSA will replicate the same logic for yellow card accumulation as players. A coach who accumulates three yellow cards (regardless of what team they are coaching) will be disqualified from the next scheduled match for the team the coach was coaching at the time of their third card issuance.
