



Independent Team Registration

Each team must have the following to compete in a UYSA Gaming League.

1. Team Administrators

- Head Coach*
- Assistant Coach*
- Team Manager

Coaching License Requirements - head coach and assistant coach must have at minimum a Grassroots License or season waiver. Click [here](#) to be directed to the

Coaching Edu page for more details on the requirements for coaches.

All team administrators MUST complete a background check, SafeSport training, and Concussion training.

2. Player Registration

- Each player is required to register through UYSA's online management system. A player must have a current photo uploaded, and a proof of age document uploaded/verified into the system.

3. Contract with a Certified League Registrar

- Certified League Registrars have gone through specific training with UYSA that allows them to provide registration services to your team(s). A list of certified league registrars can be found on our website by clicking [here](#).
- **Your registrar will make sure you meet all deadlines and team requirements to compete in a gaming league.**
 - Fall Deadline to have your team registered and applied to the league – July 1
 - Spring Deadline to have your team registered and applied to the league – February 1

4. Contract with a Certified Referee Assignor

- Referee assignors have gone through specific training by the State Referee Committee and will help provide you with eligible referees for your home games.

5. Secure a home field & Field Assignor

- Fields can be contracted with cities, school districts, or private entities.
- After you have secured a home field, you will need to request a Certificate of Liability by filling out a form [here](#).
- After contracting your field, you will need to provide the UYSA league scheduler with dates and availability you have the field for league games. Please work with the field's assignor, or if you are the assignor, notify the UYSA league scheduler via email at scheduler@uysa.org.

***Out of state teams will not be eligible for home games in their belonging city but are required to provide a home field in Utah.*

Certified Registrars, Field Assignors, and Referee Assignors are independent contractors and may charge fees for their services.

Uniform Requirement

- A jersey must display the Utah Soccer logo. A file to the image can be found on the USYA Resource Center page or by clicking [here](#).
- The jersey must display a unique number on the back of the jersey.
- The jersey may contain the Organizational Member's logo or independent member logo.
- Uniforms may contain sponsor logos and /or names under the following conditions:
 - The name and logo may not interfere with the uniform number or the UYSA logo;
 - The sponsor may not be a direct competitor of USYSA or UYSA; and
 - The sponsor must not have a product contrary to youth sports such as alcohol or tobacco.
 - All jersey sponsorships must be preapproved by the UYSA state office.
- Teams must wear colors that distinguish them from each other and from the referee and assistant referees. The home team shall wear their darker colored jerseys, and the visiting team shall wear their lighter colored jerseys.
